ESD Laminating Sheets are used for the secure storage of documents within an EPA (Electrostatic Protected Area) or cleanroom/sterile environment.

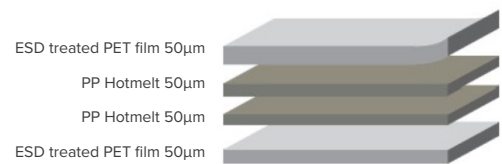
Available in two sizes, A4 and A3, ESD Laminating Sheets offer semi-permanent surface resistivity. The antistatic treated Polyethylene terephthalate (PET) film reduces electric current transfer across the surface eliminating the risk of an ESD (Electrostatic Discharge) event.
